Assignment: Room Perspective

Seventh Grade

General Information:

After studying one-point perspective techniques, we are ready to create some artwork that incorporates these drawing methods. We will be creating an interior view of a room. It can be any type of room that you might find in a house, but you need to include certain items in the drawing. You need to include a **bed or a couch**, at least **three other pieces of furniture**, a **door**, a **window**, and any other items you feel are necessary. You will also need to create an interesting floor or wallpaper design. This should be fun. Enjoy the room and make it creative!

Project criteria:

1. Create at least two thumbnail sketches that show how your room will be organized. These sketches must show the correct 3-D placement of all the required items and furniture. Use a ruler and draw each sketch as if it were the final drawing.
2. After choosing a design, draw the room on the large drawing paper provided by the teacher. Lightly place your vanishing point in the center of the wall in your room. Draw the walls and floors to establish the placement of the other objects. Remember to draw lightly, so that extra lines may be erased.
3. Erase all of the stray lines that do not need to be in the picture. Make the drawing look clean and add details to the room. When the drawing is complete, you may begin coloring and shading the objects and furniture in the room. You will have to choose a light source (use a lamp or a window that is in the drawing).
4. Write your full name and period on the back of the assignment. Fill-out a self evaluation form and staple it to the artwork. Return it to the correct "To Be Graded" location.
