Assignment: Multi-Style Animals
Seventh and Eighth Grade

General Information:

We have been studying drawing and a few of the different styles in which to draw. We know about contour line drawing, shading, and cross-hatching at this point. There are a few more styles that we can use to create a drawing.

You will create a drawing of an animal (of your choice) that is broken up into at least six different sections. Each section of the drawing will incorporate a specific drawing style from the following list: **contour line, shading, hatching, cross-hatching, and pointillism**. The final drawing will be done on a 12x18" sheet of paper.

Project criteria:

1. You may spend some time briefly looking through our classroom examples for images of an animal to draw.
2. Create at least two detailed thumbnail sketches of an animal. These sketches need to be accurate and will each be divided into six different sections by drawing lines through the image.
3. Each sketch will show the styles in the various sections. (For example, one section of the drawing will show only a detailed contour line drawing, while another may show part of the animal drawn with small dots [pointillism].)
4. When you've decided on a sketch, or animal, you will lightly draw the animal large on a 12x18" piece of paper and divide the animal into various sections (you may use a ruler).
5. Carefully complete the drawing by filling in each section with a different style. Remember not to use the same style in sections that touch each other.
5. Write your full name and period on the back of the assignment.
6. Fill-out a self evaluation form and staple it to the artwork. Return it to the correct "To Be Graded" location.
